Protection of tourist values against the background of the concept of tourist law: legal regime, management, fees, protection plans and protection tasks in special nature areas. Tourist values of a historic nature and the protection of nature and the environment. Protection of the tourist assets of health resorts. Protection of tourist assets outside special areas. Environmental impact assessment as a legal measure to protect values. Participation of the organization in the legal protection of assets. Legal responsibility for the threat and infringement of tourist values.
